

5. the duty to manage the child's estate to the extent the estate has been created by Daniel Edward Gawlikowski or his family; the parties acknowledge that as of March 10, 2005, there are no designated accounts for the benefit of the child, Brisa Gawlikowski.

**8.05 Rights and Duties of Brandi Allison Gawlikowski at All Times**

**IT IS ORDERED that Brandi Allison Gawlikowski, as a parent joint managing conservator, shall have the following rights and duty:**

1. subject to the provisions of paragraphs 9.01, the exclusive right to designate the primary residence of the child;
2. the exclusive right to consent to medical, dental, and surgical treatment involving invasive procedures after consultation with Daniel Edward Gawlikowski;
3. the exclusive right to consent to psychiatric and psychological treatment of the child after consultation with Daniel Edward Gawlikowski;
4. the exclusive right to receive and give receipt for periodic payments for the support of the child and to hold or disburse these funds for the benefit of the child;
5. the exclusive right to represent the child in legal action and to make other decisions of substantial legal significance concerning the child after consultation with Daniel Edward Gawlikowski;
6. the exclusive right to consent to marriage and to enlistment in the armed forces of the United States;
7. the exclusive right to make decisions concerning the child's education after consultation with Daniel Edward Gawlikowski;
8. except as provided by section 264.0111 of the Texas Family Code, the exclusive right to the services and earnings of the child;
9. except when a guardian of the child's estate or a guardian or attorney ad litem has been appointed for the child, the exclusive right to act as an agent of the child in relation to the child's estate if the child's action is required by a state, the United States, or a foreign government; and
